Prince of Peace ministerial badges *should be worn by all ministers at the time of their service.*

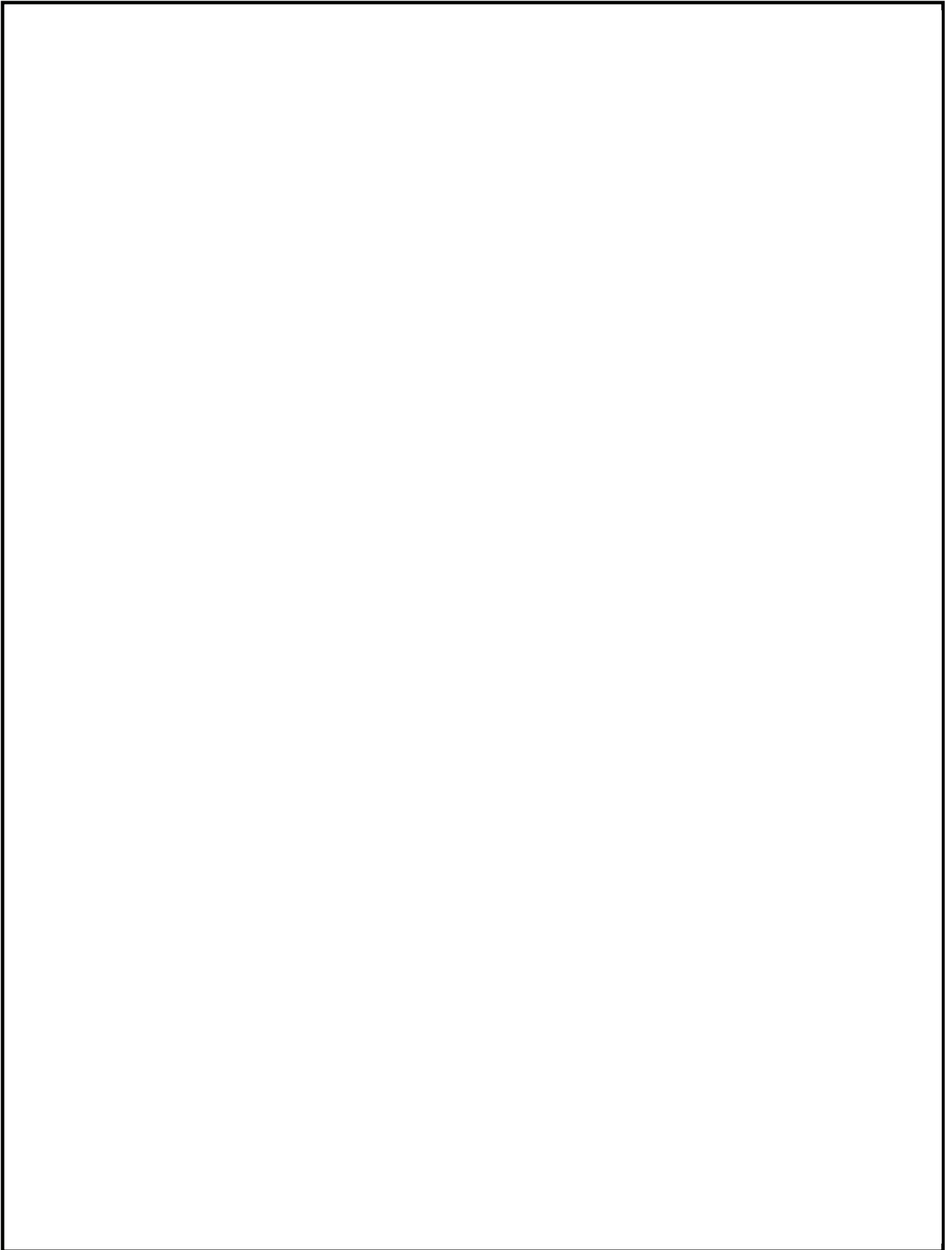
These badges display the name of the minister and their ministry so that they can be easily identified by parishioners, nursing staff, hospital patients and/or nursing home residents, parish employees, etc.
