### **FARM WORKERS MINISTRY**



The Prince of Peace Youth Group will be collecting food the weekends of **October 31st & November 1st, November 7th & 8th, and November 14th & 15th** to assist the Office of

Catholic Charities Farm Workers Ministry with their distributing Thanksgiving baskets to poor farm worker families in Crescent City and Green Cove Springs.

Food items needed include non-perishable food items (especially Hispanic ethnic foods) such as rice, dry beans, cooking oil, sugar, tomato sauce, vegetables, flour, coffee etc. Each basket will provide enough food for a family of six and will include a \$10.00 gift certificate towards the purchase of a turkey or a ham.

The goal is to distribute 200 baskets this year. Last year 150 baskets were distributed.
