2009 STEWARDSHIP WEEKEND

This weekend we celebrate Stewardship.

Stewardship is returning to God what is already His.

Making a commitment to our faith community acknowledges our desire to travel together on our faith journey with other Christians.

STUDY ON TITHING.

The following are findings stated in a report by The Barna Group. In 2007, the research revealed that just 5% of adults tithed (www.barna.org).

Not surprisingly, some population groups were more likely than others to have given away at least ten percent of their income. Among the most generous segments were:

- √Evangelicals (24% of whom tithed)
- √Conservatives (12%)
- √People who had prayed, read the Bible and attended a church service during the past week (12%);
- √Charismatic or Pentecostal Christians (11%)
- √Registered Republicans (10%).
- √Born again adults (9%)

The study also showed that Protestants were four times as likely to tithe as were Catholics (8% versus 2%, respectively).

Several groups also stood out as highly unlikely to tithe:

- People under the age of 25
- Atheists and agnostics
- Single adults who have never been married, liberals, and downscale adults.

One percent or less of the people in each of those segments tithed in 2007.

This Stewardship Weekend everyone is asked to consider this year's annual parish commitment prayerfully. Bishop Galeone urges all of us to make a pledge that will be a testament to our faith and an affirmation of our priorities.
