Each week the chalice will be presented to a participating household of faith at the 10:30 Mass. Inside the carrying case there will be vocation prayers and instructions for receiving and handling the chalice in your home. The household will display the chalice and use it as a focus for prayer for vocations throughout the week. At the end of the week, the chalice can be returned to the Sacristy before the 10:30 Mass. During the 10:30 Mass the Chalice will be presented to the next household assigned to receive it for the week.
